



A Visionary Campus – The Camp, Aix-en-Provence

Corinne Vezzoni is one of the most enlightened architects in France. Listening to her way of thinking, one would have to believe that the cities of the future will be round.

Her international campus, which is currently taking shape in the South of France, houses offices, locations for seminar rooms and workplaces in numerous circular-shaped glass pavilions. A spectacular roof supported on multiple columns stretches out over the ensemble.

Manchester is the metropolis of North England. The expanding economical location now has a new heart with the impressive office complex which architect Flanagan Lawrence has designed and brought to life. The glass façade blends in seamlessly between the cathedrals and former currency exchange offices but still impresses with a touch of class and accentuates the historical cityscape.
